

**PUBLIC SELECTION, BASED ON CURRICULUM AND INTERVIEW, FINALISED TO THE RECRUITMENT OF 1 POSITION OF PERSONNEL, TO BE RECRUITED AS TEMPORARY STAFF MEMBER, FULL TIME, TO THE FUNCTIONS OF LEVEL II – RESEARCHER IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (NATIONAL COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT ON PUBLIC RECRUITMENT, IN THE COMPARTMENTS OF RESEARCH AND INSTRUCTION OF THE 19TH APRIL 2018 – “LIVELLO 2 - PRIMO RICERCATORE – CCNL 2018 - ISTRUZIONE E RICERCA”), WITH WORKING LOCATION AT CREA-AA OF FLORENCE, RESEARCH CENTER FOR AGRICULTURE AND ENVIRONMENT OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AND THE ANALYSIS OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS, ON BEHALF OF THE PROGRAMME: “TOWARDS CLIMATE-SMART SUSTAINABLE MANAGEMENT OF AGRICULTURAL SOILS – EJP SOIL”, OB/FU 1.99.99.J5.00 – SELECTION CODE: 26/2021RM**

### Article 1

#### Positions to be recruited

Applying the Determination of the Director of the Research Center with protocol number 111509 dated 25/11/2021, it is announced a public selection, based on curricula and interview, finalized to the recruitment of 1 position of personnel, to be hired as temporary staff member, full time, to the functions of level II – researcher, in the scientific/disciplinary sector: 01 / B1 - INFORMATICS, on behalf of the research programme EJP SOIL, OB/FU 1.99.99.J5.00 held by CREA, to fulfil the following duties:

Collaborate with the EJP-SOIL task 6.1 working group to the following activities:

1. Assisting the implementation of INSPIRE compliant soil databases inside each Member State country participating to the EJP-SOIL WP6 and in the archiving of soil data in a standardized format searchable by external engines;
2. Defining soil ontologies and standard codifications;
3. Implementing with Web Services a soil distributed system which will perform queries on the connected INSPIRE compliant soil databases and will serve functionalities going from the discovering, viewing, downloading, transforming/harmonizing, up to the performing of joint functionalities (i.e. for digital soil mapping);
4. Connecting the soil distributed system to existing data catalogues and other Web applications.

The working location is at CREA-AA, Via Lanciola, 12/A - Cascine del Riccio (Florence, Italy).

The work contract duration will be **12 months**, renewable pursuant the Italian legislation, given the needs of the EJP SOIL programme and in the presence of the needed financial availability.

The overall duration of the contract cannot in any case exceed the duration of the research project for the needs of which this selection is announced, taking into account renewals, extensions and refinancing of the research project.

The following general rules for reservation in the public recruitment, based on Italian legislation, apply:

- a) Applying the art. 7, subsection 2, of the law number 68 of 12<sup>th</sup> March 1999, the disabled workers, inscribed in the list described at the article 8, subsection 2, of the same law, have a reservation right within the limits of the obligatory overall share, and up to a maximum of a half of the positions under recruitment;
- b) Applying the articles 378, subsection 9, and 1014 of the legislative decree number 66 of 15<sup>th</sup> March 2010, the 30% of the positions to be recruited is reserved to the volunteers of the armed forces, in short-term and pre-established firm, discharged without demerit or during the period of re-

engagement, to volunteers in permanent service, as well as to officers in fixed-term firm who have completed without demerit to the contracted firm.

The above mentioned reservation rights must be hold at the deadline for submitting the application, and must be expressly declared in the application; by a contrary they will not be considered.

In the absence of applicants holding the reserving rights and resulting suitable for the position to be recruited, the reserved positions will be assigned following the order of the final ranking.

The present selection is finalised to the recruitment of personnel dedicated to the fulfilment of research programmes and projects financed or co-financed by the European Commission or by other public or private financing entities; therefore, the recruitment is subordinated to the audits of entries in the CREA budget derived from the above-mentioned research programmes and projects, and consequently the participating to the selection procedure is not binding CREA to the recruitment itself.

CREA reserves his right to revoke the present selection or to make the necessary changes at any time, due to arisen organizational and service needs.

## Article 2

### Eligibility criteria

To be admitted to the selection it is required to own the following eligibility criteria:

1. **Graduation Degree (Diploma di Laurea - DL) in computer science, information technology, mathematics, physics, engineering, geology, agronomy (or equivalent), or a category of Specialistic Degree (Laurea Specialistica - LS), or a category of Magistral Degree (Laurea Magistrale - LM), which have been treated as equivalent to the above-mentioned Graduation Degree (equivalences excluded), pursuant to the Interministerial Decree of 9<sup>th</sup> July 2009 for the purposes of participation in public competitions; otherwise a MSc degree achieved abroad Italy in computer science, information technology, mathematics, physics, engineering (or equivalent), which must be recognized as equivalent, based on the Italian legislation, to the Graduation Degree (Diploma di Laurea - DL) in computer science, information technology, mathematics, physics, engineering (or equivalent).**

The qualifications obtained abroad Italy will be considered useful as long as they are recognized as equivalent to the Italian qualifications required to participate in the selection. To this purpose the details of the provision for the recognition of the equivalence to the Italian qualifications, based on current legislation, must be indicated in the application form, under penalty of exclusion; such equivalences must exist at the deadline date for the submission of the applications.

The qualifications obtained abroad will also be considered useful as long as they are equivalent, pursuant to the article 38 of the Legislative Decree number 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001, to the Italian qualifications required to participate in the selection: to this purpose, in the application for participation to the selection, the aspiring candidates must mention their foreign qualifications in the original language and request to be admitted to the selection pursuant to the article 38 of the Legislative Decree number 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001 (admission under condition); they must also send to the Department of Public Function (“Dipartimento della Funzione Pubblica”) the request for equivalence of the qualification acquired abroad, pursuant to the article 38 of the Legislative Decree number 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001. In any case, before the conclusion of the selection procedure, it will be the sole responsibility of the candidate, under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure, to produce the provision of recognition of equivalence pursuant to the article 38 of the Legislative Decree number 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001.

2. PhD or at least 2-year post-MSc-degree working experience relating to the activity indicated by the article 1 of the present selection announcement, either accrued inside research or professional

environments, preferably on behalf of qualified Research Institutions or Universities, even abroad Italy, which has permitted to the candidate to acquire a working experience in the following:

- SQL Databases (Preferable: Microsoft SQL, PostgreSQL, MySQL);
  - Structured Data Formats (Preferable: Json, XML, Atom, CSV);
  - Structured Data Schemes (Preferable: ER model, RDBMS, UML, XSD);
  - OOP programming languages (Preferable: C#, Python, Java);
  - Ontology & Semantic Web (Preferable: Web Ontology Language - OWL, Resource Description Framework - RDF).
3. to have an adequate understanding of the English language;
  4. to have an adequate knowledge of the use of the most widespread computer equipment and applications;
  5. to have the Italian citizenship or the citizenship of a member state of the European Union or third countries with the limits set out in article 38 of the Legislative Decree number 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001;
  6. to enjoy of political rights;
  7. to have the physical fitness to the employment, with the authority of the Administration to submit the winner of the selection to a medical check-up according to current legislation;
  8. to have a regular position towards military obligations.

Cannot be admitted to the selection procedure, those who have been excluded from the active political electorate, those who have been dismissed or dispensed from employment in a Public Administration for persistent insufficient performance, or have been declared forfeited for having obtained employment through the production of false documents or documents vitiated by non-remediable invalidity, or those who have been banned from public offices on the basis of a final judgment, or those who are in any case prevented from accessing public employment pursuant to current legislation.

The requisites prescribed by this article must be possessed by the candidate on the due date for submission of the application to be admitted to the selection.

The admission to the selective tests takes place with the expressed reserve of a subsequent verification of the possession of the prescribed requirements.

In the absence of the requirements for admission, the Administration may, at any time, dispose the exclusion from the selection of candidates properly classified in the final ranking, with a justified provision, even after the competition tests have been carried out.

**Though not mandatory, and not part of the eligibility criteria, the expertise in the following areas will be considered in the selection process:**

- **OGC Services & INSPIRE standards and tools (Preferable WPS, WMS, WFS, WCS and CSW. Optional PyWPS, OWSLib, PyCSW);**
- **Geospatial Transformation Softwares (Preferable: Hale-studio, FME, XSLT);**
- **Web technologies (Preferable: CSS, HTML, Javascript, Django, ASP.NET);**
- **Web services development (RESTful APIs development, Web Server deployment)**
- **Working by continuous approaches such as continuous integration (CI) and continuous deployment (CD) (Preferable: Azure DevOps, Jenkins);**
- **GIS software such as GeoServer/M apBox, Hale/FME, QGIS/ArcGIS;**
- **Spatial analysis using R, Grass or similar;**
- **Affinity with the soil domain.**

### Article 3

#### Application form for participation

The application form for participation in the selection procedure must be drawn up exclusively using the specific form attached to this announcement (attachment 1).

The applications for participation in the selection must be sent **exclusively** by certified electronic mail (PEC) to the address: [aa@pec.crea.gov.it](mailto:aa@pec.crea.gov.it) within the deadline for the call, taking care to attach all the required documentation in pdf format. The requests and declarations sent according to the aforementioned method (electronic mail PEC) will be valid if made in accordance with the provisions of the article 65 of Legislative Decree number 82 of 7<sup>th</sup> March 2005 (Digital Administration Code).

**For candidates applying from abroad the Italian territory, the sending of the applications for participation with different means respect to the certified electronic mail (PEC) will be accepted.**

The wording " **Domanda di partecipazione alla selezione pubblica Codice 26/2021RM**" must be placed in the email subject.

Beyond the due date for submission, it is not allowed the regularization of the application by candidates who have omitted, totally or partially, even only one of the required declarations.

Applications sent from an e-mail address other than a PEC address, and those received using methods other than those indicated in the announcement will not be accepted.

Attached documents are allowed in pdf format only; each attachment can have a maximum size of 30MB (MegaByte) and all attachments can have a maximum overall size of 100MB (MegaByte), measured after their eventual compression.

Attachments and application can be compressed. The use of zip or rar compressed formats is allowed, as long as they contain files in pdf format and do not have a password.

The maximum size of the e-mail sent, including attachments, allowed by the CREA computer system is 100 MB (MegaByte). Any inconvenience in the delivery of certified e-mail caused by exceeding the maximum size of the message allowed will be attributable exclusively to the candidate who therefore will not be able to raise objections of any kind in this regard.

CREA is authorized to use the same means as the certified e-mail for each communication, with full effectiveness and guarantee of knowledge of the documents transmitted by the candidate.

The requests and declarations sent according to the aforementioned method will be valid if made according to one of the following methods, pursuant to the article 65 of Legislative Decree number 82 of 7<sup>th</sup> March 2005 (Digital Administration Code):

- application digitally signed;
- application with handwritten signature on paper, in full and legible form, with a copy of a valid identity document. The signed application and the copy of the document must be scanned separately in pdf format and sent via certified e-mail. The application, digitally signed or autographed, as specified above, can be sent by the candidate through his / her PEC certified e-mail box (own digital domicile), provided that the relative access credentials have been issued after identification of the owner and that this is certified by the system manager in the message or in an attachment. In this case, the transmission constitutes an election of special domicile pursuant to the article 47 of the Italian Civil Code.

The application may also be sent from a certified email address of another subject, provided that the relative access credentials are issued after identification of the owner and this is certified by the system manager in the message or in an attachment.

Any variation of the elected domicile for the purposes of communications concerning the selection must be promptly reported by the candidate. The Administration assumes no responsibility for the non-

receipt of applications, nor for the failure to return the acknowledgment of receipt, due to unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure.

Pursuant to the Decree of the President of the Republic n. 445/2000, the declarations made and signed in the aforementioned participation application have the value of self-certification; the falsification of documents and false declarations are subjected to the penalties provided for in Article 76 of the aforementioned Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000.

In accordance with current legislation and under penalty of exclusion from the selection, the candidate must attach to the application a valid copy of his/her identity document.

In the application form, the candidate must indicate:

- a) his/her name and surname;
- b) the place and date of birth;
- c) the residence (street, house number, municipality, province, post code, country) and the personal email;
- d) the address where the candidate intends to receive communications concerning the selection procedure (indicate only if different from the residence);
- e) to be in possession of Italian citizenship or of one of the member states of the European Union or of third countries with the limits set out in art. 38 of Legislative Decree 165/2001;
- f) the enjoyment of civil and political rights;
- g) if an Italian citizen, the municipality in whose electoral lists he is registered, or the reasons for non-registration or cancellation from the same lists;
- h) not to have received criminal convictions and not to have pending criminal proceedings, or any reported convictions, even if amnesty, pardon or judicial pardon has been granted. The declaration must be made even in the absence of criminal convictions;
- i) not having been dismissed or dispensed from employment in a public administration due to persistent insufficient performance; that he has not been declared forfeited from a state employment pursuant to Article 127, paragraph 1, letter d), of the Consolidated Law on civil servants of the Italy, approved by Decree of the President of the Republic number 3 of 10<sup>th</sup> January 1957; not having reported the ancillary penalty of termination of the employment or employment relationship pursuant to Article 32-quinquies of the Criminal Code; not having been dismissed as a result of disciplinary proceedings pursuant to article 28 of the national collective labor agreement of the sector of research and experimentation institutions and bodies signed on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2002 and subsequent amendments and additions, or of the corresponding provisions of national collective work agreements related to the staff of other sectors;
- j) possession of the qualification referred to in the Article 2, paragraph 1 of this announcement, with the exact indication of the year and the Institute at which it was obtained;
- k) possession of PhD or documented at least 2-year post-MSc-degree working experience relating to the activity indicated by the article 2, paragraph 2 of the present selection announcement, either accrued inside research or professional environments, preferably on behalf of qualified Research Institutions or Universities, even abroad Italy,
- l) basic knowledge of English language;
- m) knowledge of basic informatics;
- n) the position held with regard to military obligations;

- o) physical fitness for the job for which it competes;
- p) possible possession of qualifications that give rise to preference, pursuant to the article 5, paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Decree of the President of the Republic no. 487 of 1994 and subsequent amendments and additions (attachment 2). These qualifications, if not expressly stated in the admission application, will not be taken into consideration when drawing up the final ranking;
- q) the possible possession of the recognition of the disabled status and / or belonging to the protected categories as respectively governed by the articles 1 and 18, of the law number 68 of 12<sup>th</sup> March 1999.

Candidates must attach to the application form:

- a. *curriculum vitae et studiorum* in which the candidate will indicate the studies completed, the qualifications obtained, the publications, the services provided, and any other scientific, technological, professional and didactic activity that the candidate deems useful to produce for the purposes of the evaluation;
- b. the documents and qualifications referred to in the *curriculum vitae et studiorum*, which the candidate deems useful to produce for the purposes of the evaluation, must be attached in a copy declared conform to the original by means of a substitutive declaration of the deed of notoriety made pursuant to article 47 of the same decree (attachment 3).

The declarations, indicated above, must be drawn up in an analytical way, and contain all the elements that make them usable for the purposes of the selection, so that the qualifications to which they refer can be usefully evaluated. False declarations or falsity of documents, referred to in article 76 of the aforementioned Decree of the President of the Republic, are punished pursuant to the criminal code and special laws on the subject.

The Administration reserves the right to carry out suitable checks on the veracity of the content of the self-declarations.

The assessable qualifications, referred to in the article 5 of the present selection announcement, may also be produced by means of a substitutive declaration of certification made pursuant to Article 46 of the Decree of the President of the Republic 445/2000 (attachment 4);

- c. detailed list of all documents and qualifications referred to in point b) above.

A translation in Italian must be attached to documents and qualifications written in a foreign language. Candidates of citizenship other than Italian must also declare that they enjoy civil and political rights in the country of origin, or the reasons for not enjoying the rights themselves.

Handicapped candidates must, pursuant to Article 20 of Law no. 104/1992, specify, in relation to their handicap, the necessary aid as well as the possible need for additional time in relation to the performance of the examination tests. They will also have to attach a certification issued by a specific health facility which, in relation to the specific handicap and the type of test to be taken, indicates the essential elements necessary for the use of the required benefits in order to allow the Administration to prepare the means and tools to guarantee the interested parties regular participation in the selection.

Candidates who have submitted the application without signature, an incomplete application, or an irregular application will be excluded from the selection procedure. In particular, candidates whose applications do not contain all the information about the possession of the requisites and all the required declarations will not be admitted to the selection procedure.

#### **Article 4**

##### **Examining commission**

The Examining Commission is appointed by the Director of the Research Center pursuant to the article 9 of the Regulations for the recruitment of personnel with fixed-term employment contracts and is composed of a Chairman and two members, experts in the subjects being selected and makes use of a

secretary. The appointment of the Commission is carried out in compliance with the provisions of Article 35 bis, paragraph 1, letter a) of Legislative Decree no. 165 of 30<sup>th</sup> March 2001.

**The Commission may also meet electronically.**

#### **Article 5**

##### **Evaluable qualifications in the curriculum and interview**

The selection is done by curriculum evaluation and in person interview. The overall score that can be attributed is 90 points divided as follows:

- curriculum *max scores 20*
- interview *max scores 70*

The evaluation of qualifications will precede the examination by means of an interview.

For the evaluation of qualifications, the Commission will have a maximum of **20 scores**, divided as follows:

a) Academic qualifications and other degrees, trainings (qualifications higher than those required for admission, such as professional certificates, internships, masters, professional qualifications, professional refresher courses, relating to the area of specialization referred to in articles 1 and 2 of this announcement).

Max 1 score for each qualification.

**(max scores 4)**

b) Work experience (further than the 3 years required as an admission in case of lacking the PhD, relevant to the topic of selection, provided, through any form provided for by law, at public and private research bodies and universities or other public administrations or private employers, assessed for duration and relevance to the area of specialization referred to in articles 1 and 2 of this announcement)

Max 1.5 scores for year (or fraction of year larger than 6 months)

**(max scores 6)**

c) Positions and professional titles (positions of responsibility of complex organizational structures, positions of project responsibility, other positions of responsibility for specific functions, procedural responsibility, appointment in commissions, committees and official ministerial technical tables, high-level teaching, related with the area of specialization referred to in articles 1 and 2 of this announcement).

Max 1 score for each qualification.

**(max scores 2)**

d) Scientific and technical publications (publications, technical papers, drafting of institutional documents and working documents relating to the area of specialization referred to in Articles 1 and 2 of this announcement).

Max 0.5 scores for work in relation to the relevance.

**(max scores 3)**

e) Overall evaluation of the curriculum vitae et studiorum.

**(max scores 5)**

The Examining Commission will establish the type of qualifications within the categories referred to in the previous paragraph and the related scores attributable to each qualification.

The qualifications constituting requirements for access to this selection cannot be evaluated.

The qualifications will be evaluated only if held by the candidate at the deadline date for submitting the application for participation.

Only candidates reaching an evaluation score no less than **14/20** in the evaluation of their qualifications from the curriculum, will be admitted to the interview.

Candidates admitted to the interview will be notified **with PEC** of the date, place and time in which they will have to present themselves to take part to the interview, at least **20 days** in advance.

At the same time, with publication on the CREA institutional website [www.crea.gov.it](http://www.crea.gov.it), section competition notices, the same communication will be given indicating the score reported in the evaluation of the qualifications. Before carrying out the interview, each candidate will be notified of the grade obtained in the evaluation of qualifications.

The Commission will have a total of 70 scores for the evaluation of the interview.

The interview will be aimed at verifying the specific knowledge typical of the professional profile of **Level II – IT Researcher**, and the subjects relating to the chosen area of specialization referred to in Articles 1 and 2), also through the discussion of the qualifications presented. Only the candidates who have obtained a minimum score of **49/70** in the interview exam will be declared suitable.

At the end of the session relating to the interview examination, the Commission will draw up the list of candidates with the indication of the mark obtained by each in the interview; this list, signed by the president and secretary of the Commission, will be published on the CREA website.

#### **Article 6**

##### **Identification documents**

In order to be admitted to the oral tests, candidates must, if the document sent during the presentation of the application has expired in the meantime, send a valid document.

#### **Article 7**

##### **Titles of preference in case of equal merit**

Candidates who have passed the interview exam and intend to assert their preference titles, in case of equal merit as indicated in the application form, must submit to the Council for Research in Agriculture and the Analysis of Agricultural Economics - Research Center for Agriculture and Environment, via PEC the documents certifying the possession of these qualifications at the deadline for submitting applications for admission to the competition.

The qualifications referred to in this article will be evaluated only if presented within fifteen days.

#### **Article 8**

##### **Elaboration and publication of the final ranking**

Once the work has been completed, the Examining Commission will proceed with the elaboration of the final ranking, in descending order of the overall score achieved by each candidate, resulting from the sum of the scores obtained in the evaluation of qualifications and the scores reported in the interview examination.

With the same scores, the Administration will evaluate the preference and / or precedence qualifications indicated in paragraphs 4 and 5 of art. 5 of Presidential Decree 487/1994.

The final ranking with the identification of the winners, approved by a specific provision of the Director of the Research Center, will be published on the CREA institutional website: [www.crea.gov.it](http://www.crea.gov.it), section Competitions notices. From the date of publication of the rankings, the terms for any appeals will run.

#### **Article 9**

##### **Hiring procedure**

The winner, after producing the documents referred to in the following art. 10 will be invited to sign, pursuant to the national collective bargaining agreement in force, an individual contract aimed at establishing a fixed-term employment relationship.

Upon hiring, the winners will be given the code of conduct for CREA employees.



The hired personnel are entitled to the salary provided for by the current legislation and by the national contractual provisions of the Research Section for the profile referred to in this announcement, starting from the effective hiring date assigned by CREA.

The aforementioned staff must take up service on the date that will be communicated by the institution itself. Otherwise, it will be forfeited from the ranking.

Hiring for a justified reason, with delay on the set deadline, means that the economic effects start from the first day of service.

Hiring into service is subject to acceptance of all applicable regulations for the staff of CREA. The aforementioned personnel will be paid the salary provided for by the national collective bargaining agreement in force for the professional position.

Failure to submit to service without justified reason, or failure to produce the required documentation or failure to regularize the documentation itself within the prescribed time limits or the production of documents affected by irremediable defects, will result in failure to sign the employment contract.

## **Article 10**

### **Presentation of documents**

The selected personnel must submit, within the peremptory term of 10 days, which starts from the day of receipt of the relative invitation by CREA, under penalty of not giving rise to the subsequent stipulation of the individual contract, a declaration, signed with their own responsibility and pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, certifying that the conditions, facts and personal qualities, susceptible to modification, self-certified by the application for admission to the selection, have not changed.

Within the same 10-day period, the successful candidate will also be invited to submit or send by PEC with acknowledgment of receipt the declaration of non-existence of situations of incompatibility and accumulation of employment pursuant to Article 53 of Legislative Decree no. 165/2001 and subsequent amendments; if so, he will have to submit a declaration of option for the new job. This declaration must contain any declarations concerning the causes for termination of the previous relationship. In accordance with art. 71 of the same DPR n. 445/2000, the Administration will carry out suitable checks, including random checks, on the veracity of the aforementioned declarations, with the consequences set out in the following articles 75 and 76 in case of untruthful or false statements. Once the aforementioned deadline has expired, the Administration communicates not to give rise to the recruitment.

The Administration reserves the right to ascertain the physical fitness of the suitable candidates.

## **Article 11**

### **Treatment of personal data**

Pursuant to art. 13 of the general regulation for the protection of personal data n. 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR), the personal data provided by the participants are collected at the Agriculture and Environment Research Center, for the management purposes for the procedure and used for the purposes inherent to the procedure itself and for the management of any consequent relationship. The same data may be disclosed to third parties solely for the purposes of the law.

The data controller is CREA in the person of the pro tempore Legal Representative. The contact person for the processing of personal data - as the subjective attribution center of the activities aimed at ensuring the protection obligations envisaged by the Data Controller and in support of the latter pursuant to the decree of the Vice President No. 31 of 23/4/2019 - is the Director of the Research Center.

The provision of data is mandatory for the purposes of assessing the participation requirements, under penalty of exclusion from the selection. The interested party can exercise the rights referred to in

Articles 15-22 of the aforementioned GDPR.

#### **Article 12**

##### **Access to documents**
